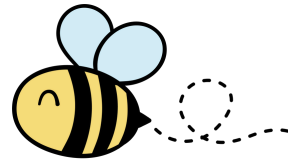




A Spring Mad Lib

"Yum!" said [2_____], who took out some [13_____] flavored juice from their bag.

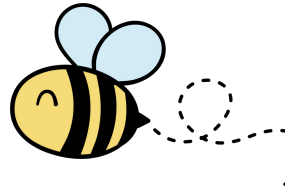
