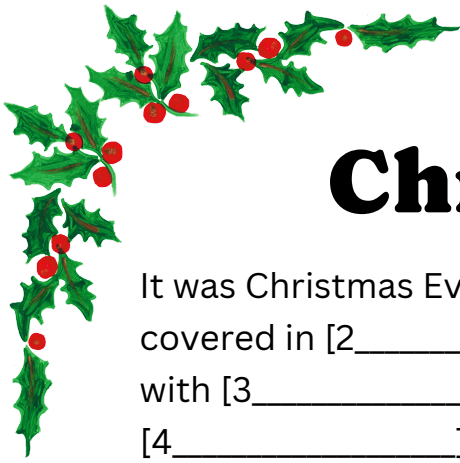




Christmas Mad Lib

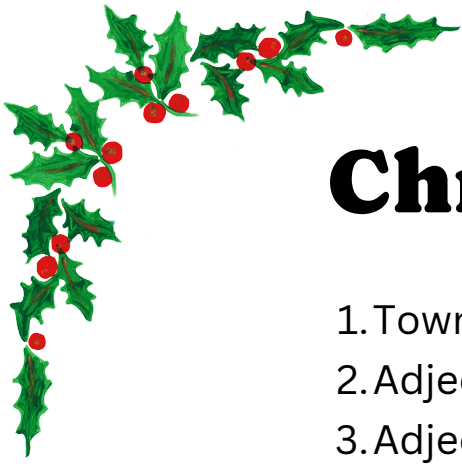
