

A Summer Mad Lib



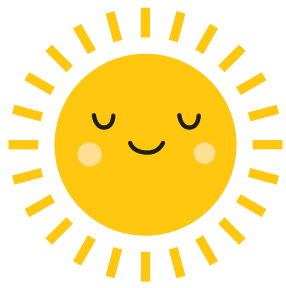
