[1_____] is fascinated about mermaids and is writing a large book of facts about them.

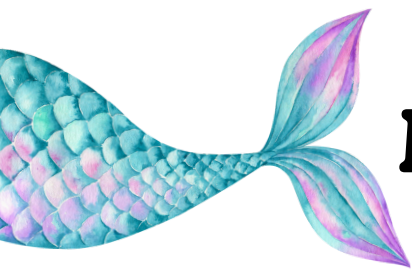
