## **Christmas Charades - Game Rules**

The aim of Christmas Charades is to guess words or phrases related to the holiday season acted out by your teammates. No speaking or sounds are allowed.

Divide players into two or more teams. Each team takes turns performing and guessing.

## Playing the Game:

On their turn, a player from the active team selects a card and acts out the word or phrase without speaking or making noise.

Their team has a set time (usually 1 minute) to guess the word or phrase.

If the team guesses correctly within the time limit, they score a point.

After each turn, the next team goes.

## Rules:

No talking or mouthing words.

No pointing at objects in the room.

Sounds and words (like "um" or "ah") are not allowed.

Gestures and pantomime are the only methods of communication.
